

DIFFERENTIATED FEES

WHO IS CONCERNED?

Not subject to differentiated fees

- Students of French nationality;
- Nationals of the EU, the EEA, Monaco, Andorra, Quebec or Switzerland;
- Doctoral students and those enrolled for the accreditation to supervise research (HDR);
- Refugees, beneficiaries of subsidiary protection, and their children;
- Long-term residents in France, and their minor children;
- Those with tax residency in France for more than 2 years (attached to the tax household);
- Students in CPGE (preparatory classes for the Grandes Écoles);
- Recipients of higher education scholarships awarded by the State, in particular means-tested scholarships (BCS) and French government scholarships (BGF) awarded by the Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs;
- Wards of the Nation and wards of the Republic;
- Students benefiting from an exemption for the 2025-2026 academic year remain governed by the previous provisions until the end of their university cycle (the entirety of a bachelor's or master's cycle), provided they continue in the same program and at the same institution;
- Students whose application was accepted by UPVD before 21/05/2026 (i.e. up to and including 20/05/2026), the date on which Decree No. 2026-385 of 19 May 2026 came into force.

Subject to differentiated fees

- International mobility students who do not fall under any of the non-liability situations listed above.
